Rules & Regulations

- The USTA "Code of Ethics" will be in effect.
- Each team must have a team name
- Each team must be comprised of at least two men and two women. A team may not have more than eight players. All players must be 18. This is an adult only tournament. Any 18 year-old playing in the team tournament cannot play in the junior tournament.
- A team match will be one men's doubles match, one women's doubles match and one mixed doubles match.
- A player can play men's or women's doubles and also play mixed doubles in each team match.
- There are two divisions: 8.0 and 7.0 For each division, each doubles team cannot have a combined NTRP ranking higher than the division.. Accordingly for the 8.0 division, a 4.5 player can play with a 3.5 player and two 4.0 players can play together, but a 4.5 player cannot play with a 4.0 player. The tournament committee shall have sole authority to determine whether a doubles team's ranking is too high. This is a fun team tournament. Do your best to keep it fair and competitive.
- Each doubles match will be first to five games. If a set reaches 4-4, a nine-point tiebreaker is played to decide the winner of the set. A tiebreaker is won by the first team to reach five points. Players change sides after four points. The tiebreaker counts as one game and decides the outcome of the set.
- Game scoring is no-ad (first team to win four points wins the game). Should the game reach deuce (3 points each), the receiver chooses the side from which he/she will receive serve. In mixed doubles, the serve is always gender to gender at deuce. Each game counts as one point in the team's cumulative match score. Players change sides after every four games. Lets are played and either partner may return the let serve.
- You can sub in players between points in a match (so all your players could theoretically play in a mixed match). But a player who has been subbed out may not sub back in.
- Coaching is allowed and encouraged. Teammates may be on the court to cheer.
- Check in time is 15 minutes before the scheduled match.
- Default time is 15 minutes after the scheduled match.
- No team will be entered into the draw until entry fees are paid for every player. Entry fees will not be refunded once the team has been entered into the draw. No telephone entries accepted.
- Turn entry forms in at the Alaska Club North & East tournament drop boxes.
- The tournament will provide USTA approved balls.
- Players are limited to a 10 minute warm-up (including serves) before each match.
- Additional information will be given to team captains.
- Captains are responsible for explaining the rules to their players.
- Captains must provide an email address. The draw will be sent by email.
